Psalm 139: 7-8 "Where can I go from your Spirit?

Where can I flee from your presence?

If I go up to the heavens, you are there;

If I make my bed in the depths, you are there."

John 14:6b "No one comes to the Father except through me."

<u>VERSE 1</u>: <u>One day as I was a walkin' along the heav'nly road,</u>

My Savior spoke unto me and He filled my heart with His love.

John 13:34b "As I have loved you, so you must love one another." I John 4:19 "We love because He first loved us."

VERSE 2: I'll take my gospel trumpet and I'll begin to blow,
And if my Savior helps me I'll blow wherever I'll go.

In Scripture, the trumpet is of a signal of important events and messages to come.

Isaiah 27:13 – a trumpet sound called the exiles to worship

Matthew 24:31 – a trumpet sound will signal Christ's second coming

The trumpet in the anthem is the all-important sharing of the Gospel message to all people.

Matthew 28:19 – "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...."
