

Anthem: "Built on a Rock" Based on "The Church's One Foundation" by Samuel J. Stone (1839-1900) Words and Music by Joel Raney

Samuel J. Stone wrote twelve hymn texts based on the Apostles' Creed. The hymn "The Church's One Foundation" refers to the ninth article stating belief in the holy catholic (universal) church and the communion of saints. In the hymn, Stone reaffirms the Lordship of Christ as the foundation of the church.¹

THE CHURCH

The Rock.

The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. Psalm 18:2

In Matt. 16:16-18, when the apostle Peter proclaimed Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God, Jesus responded "...on this rock, I will build my church." John Wesley wrote that Jesus was alluding to Peter's name, which signifies a rock, but it was the faith which Peter professed on which Jesus would build his Church." Wesley continued to write that Scripture states Jesus is the only foundation of the Church, and that is what the apostles preached. It is for their faith and teaching, that the names of the twelve apostles (not Peter only) will be inscribed on the twelve foundations of the wall of the city of God as stated in Rev. 21:14.
